Chinn Planning, Inc. and KMD Justice were hired by the State of Arkansas in April 2006 to develop a Juvenile Operational and Facilities Master Plan for the Department of Health and Human Services, Division of Juvenile Services. The goal of the master plan was development of operational and facility improvements and an implementation plan to meet program, treatment, operational and facility needs of juvenile offenders committed to DYS custody. DYS has direct operational authority for eight juvenile correctional and treatment facilities operated from five sites. DYS also contracts with specialty providers throughout the state to meet the treatment needs of juvenile offenders.

The planning process involved numerous meetings with advisory committees to guide the development of the master plan. These included meetings to review the system and facility assessment, projected capacity requirements, best practices in juvenile operation and facility design, options for program improvements and expansion, and recommended capacity requirements and system recommendations.

Recommendations presented to the Arkansas Division of Youth Services included:

- Revise Mission Statement
- Provide Regional Coordination of Services
- Expand Community Based Services
- Enhance Risk Assessment and Intake Process
- Improve Operational Control Over DYS Facilities
- Reduce Average Length of Stay in DYS Custody
- Develop Short Term Residential Programming
- Expand Capacity for Special Needs Offenders
- Improve Treatment Program Selection and Delivery
- Decommission Two Antiquated Facilities and Replace and Expand DYS Facilities
