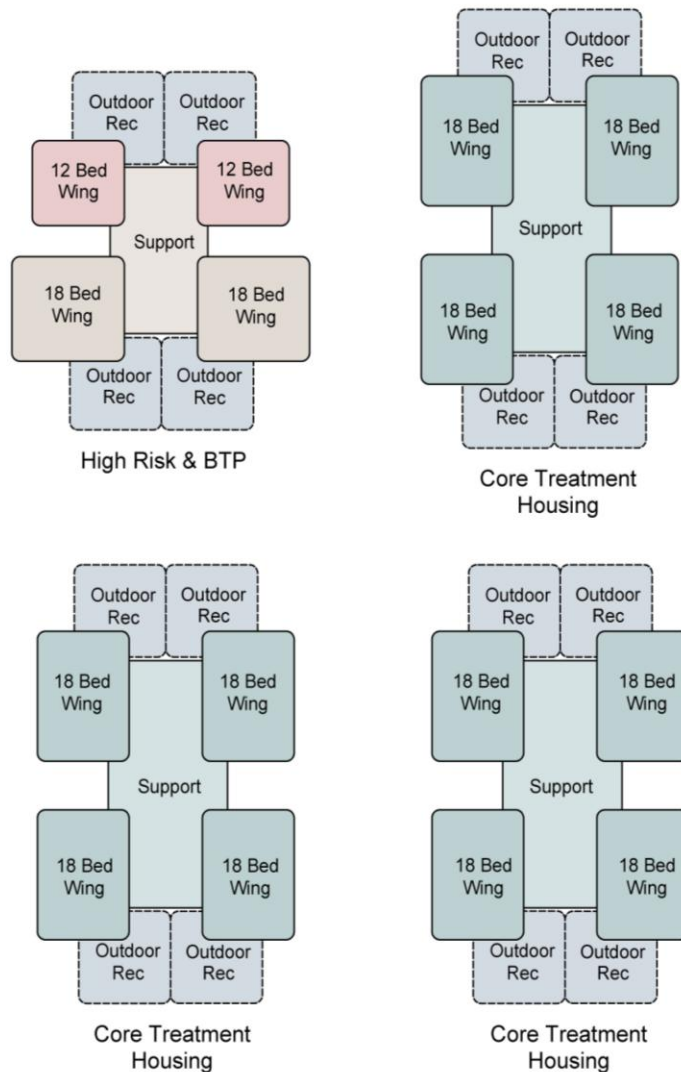

In a major reorganization of California state correctional departments in 2005, the Department formerly known as the California Youth Authority (CYA) became the Division of Juvenile Justice (DJJ), under the California Department of Corrections and Rehabilitation (CDCR). DJJ is committed to implementing a rehabilitative treatment model for youth, with an emphasis on education, training, and treatment services. As a rehabilitative treatment agency, DJJ began planning for three general types of treatment programs: a core treatment program for most youth, a behavior treatment for aggressive youth without significant mental health problems, and an intensive treatment program for mentally ill youth and youth requiring substance abuse or sexual behavior treatment.

In 2007 and 2009, the Division of Juvenile Justice contracted with KMD Justice and Chinn Planning, Inc. to provide programming and architectural services for the Northern California Core Treatment Facility. Chinn Planning, Inc. conducted a series of meetings with a Core Planning/Review Group to develop a detailed architectural program, adjacency diagrams, and a staffing plan for the 276 Bed Facility. Total programmed Gross Square Feet was 187,000.
