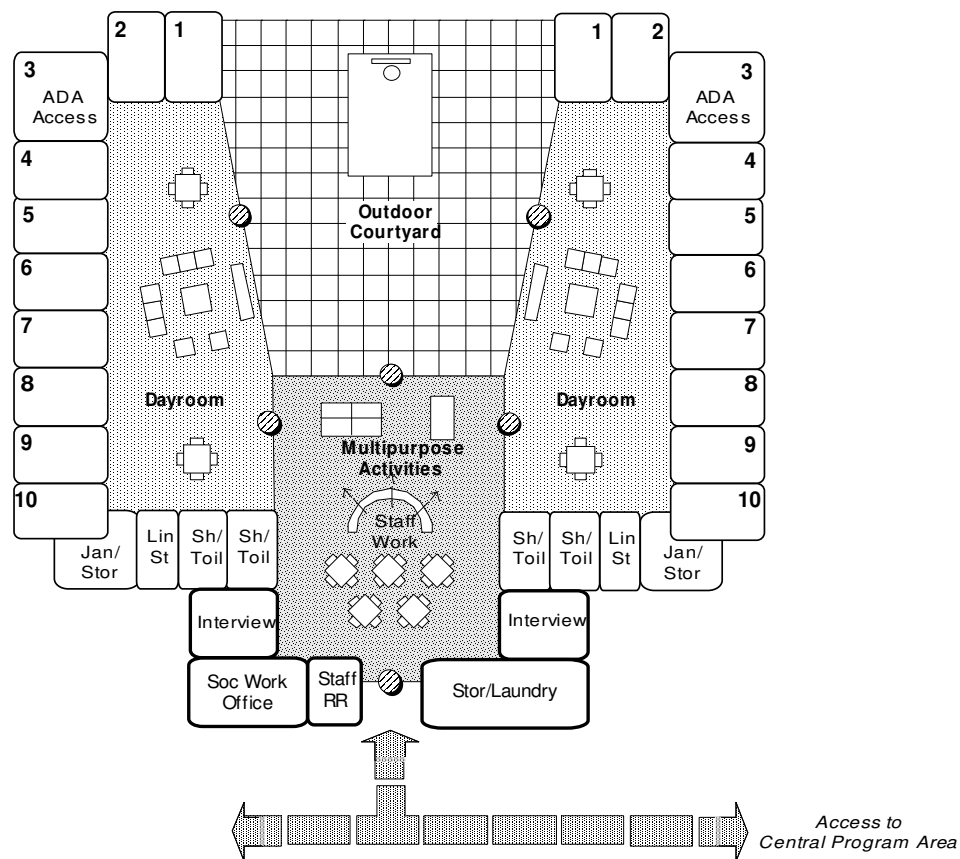

Chinn Planning, Inc., was hired in 2002 to develop a detailed operational and architectural program for the Cuyahoga County Youth Intervention Center. The Youth Intervention Center would replace the existing youth detention center, and would combine other service functions at one function. Elements of the Youth Intervention Center include court; probation and court support; detention alternatives programs; intake and assessment; secure detention; staff secure detention; and all associated support space for detention. The County put the project on hold in late 2002, in order to conduct a needs assessment study to review the size of the facility. In early, 2003, the County decided to develop secure detention capacity of 150 beds, with staff secure capacity of 30 to 40 beds. The site will be master planned for future expansion. The Youth Intervention Center will also have public support space which will serve the community where the facility will be located.
