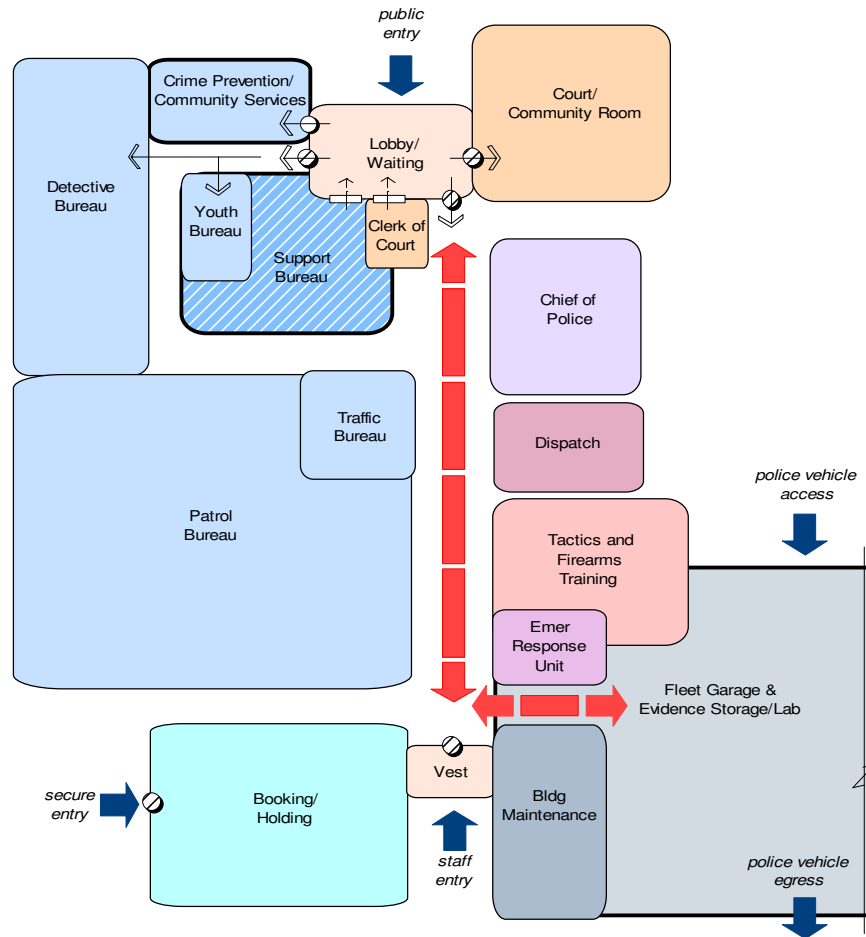

An operational and architectural program for a new police facility was developed for the City of Oak Creek. The development of the space program and cost estimate was conducted in a sequential process that assessed the personnel, operational and spatial needs of the Oak Creek Police Department. Using a survey form, interviews with police department staff, extensive experience in other law enforcement systems and a variety of collected data, a portrait of the police department and its operations was developed. Personnel projections and space standards for various categories of personnel and support spaces were reviewed with the Police Department Future Needs Committee prior to the development of the space listing. Detailed space listings and functional adjacency diagrams were developed for each component of the Police Department and reviewed with Police Department staff and the Police Department Future Needs Committee. Finally, a detailed construction cost and total project cost budget was developed.
